Information

How do I sign up to get my videos?

Email me at Karen@FidoPhotography.net **before** the trial or sign up at the registration table when you check in on trial day. There's no obligation to buy your videos no matter when or how you sign up.

How do I pay for my videos?

At the end of your trial day you can pay with cash, a check made out to **Fido Photography**, a credit card or you can request a Paypal invoice. After the trial you can contact me by email to order your videos.

How long does it take to get my videos?

Videos that are paid for at the trial are delivered within **a week** of the **end** of the trial. If you order after the trial, it depends on how many orders there are in the editing queue, but generally the delivery time is less than a week from when your payment is received.

If you don't have your download link within a week please **check your spam filter** and if the email isn't there contact me right away.

How do you deliver the videos? Should I bring a flash drive to the trial?

You'll receive an email link to your files from a file transfer service so you can download them to your computer, tablet or phone.

If you would like me to mail you a flash drive then bring one to the trial and I'll mail it to you with your videos on it. Mailing service is \$5. 4GB flash drives are \$5 if you'd like me to provide one for you.

Do you video all the elements?

The NACSW doesn't allow any photography in interiors so I'm not able to video interior elements.

How long do I have to decide if I want to buy my videos?

I keep the videos for at least a week after the trial, but they take up a tremendous amount of memory so I delete them before I shoot the next trial.

Can I post my videos on Facebook?

Yes, definitely! For sharp videos on Facebook link to YouTube rather than uploading directly to Facebook.
